Note: The difference in Paul's teaching between Jew and Gentile is a direct result of Christ's direction and Paul's Commission in Acts 15:5,10,19-21. It concerned the ceremonial/sacrificial law written by Moses, *Deut. 31:24*; Acts 13:39 And **by him all that believe are justified** from all things, from which ye could not be justified **by the law of Moses**. *Gal. 3:19*. Rom. 10:4 For **Christ is the end of the law**—for righteousness—to every one that believeth. *Dan. 9:27*, which some who err believe it also includes the Ten Commandments written by God—These Ten Commandments are still binding as Paul testifies. The remedy for their violation lay not in sacrificial offering of animals but in Jesus whom these were designed to teach.
