

Of Jesus Service.

Isa. 53:12 . . . because he hath poured out his soul unto death: . . . ; Ps. 22:14 I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels. 15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death. 16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet. John 21:24 This is the disciple which testifieth of these things, and wrote these things: and we know that his testimony is true. 25 And there are also many other things *which Jesus did*, the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Amen.

Lev. 9:9 . . . and poured out the blood at the bottom of the altar: Due. 12:27 . . . shall be poured out upon the altar . . .

The Widows Mite.

Luke 21:3 And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all: 4 For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had. Mark 12:42 And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing. 43 And he called unto him his disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury: 44 For all they did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living.

Note: This Widows commendation was not where she gave, for shortly this corrupted system-this churches probation would close and be replaced.

Commendation was given for her service not what she gave but what it cost her to give: all her effort, dedication, all the service of love she had learned to give. Pastors have kept this from us because they've decided it has no value. Hence why Jesus' efforts were for the common people. It may be that ere long all prophesyings among us will be at an end, and the voice which has stirred the people may no longer disturb their carnal slumbers. 5T 77.1

Eph. 6:6 . . . as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart; 7 With good will **doing service**, as to the Lord, and not to men: 8 **Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth**, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether he be bond or free.

Is your service for God held sacred by Pastors, Ministers Elders.

2Sam 23:15 And David longed, and said, Oh that one would give me drink of the water of the well of Bethlehem, which is by the gate! 16 And the three mighty men brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that was by the gate, and took it, and brought it to David: nevertheless he would not drink thereof, but poured it out unto the LORD. 17 And he said, Be it far from me, O LORD, that I should do this: **is not this the blood of the men that went in jeopardy of their lives?** therefore he would not drink it. These things did these three mighty men.

Job. 3:24 For my sighing cometh before I eat, and my roarings are **poured out like the waters**. Ps 142:2 I poured out my complaint before him; I shewed before him my trouble. Rev. 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and **they loved not their lives unto the death**.

Phil. 2:30 Because for the work of Christ he" Timotheus "was nigh unto death, not regarding his life, **to supply your lack of service toward me**. Rev. 2:19 I know **thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works**; and the last to be more than the first.

Gal. 5:13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love **serve one another**. Ps. 16:2 O my soul, thou hast said unto the LORD, Thou art my Lord: **my goodness extendeth** not to thee; 3 **But to the saints that are in the earth, and to the excellent, in whom is all my delight**.

Note: David declares his goodness learned from God extended to the saints—David did good to them. Here is seen what Jones and Waggoner rejected, Service and the Sanctuary Message. Which taught the real meaning of Righteousness by Faith.

John 15:13 Greater love hath no man than this, *that a man lay down his life for his friends.* 14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.

Note Works, Sacrifice, Obedience, Keep, Done, Do, all refer to Service.
