

John. 18:36 Jesus answered, ***My kingdom is not of this world:*** if my kingdom were of this world, then would my *servants* fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is ***my kingdom not from hence. Eph. 3:10--"in heavenly places,"*;Col. 2:15****

John 6:15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and ***take him by force, to make him a king,*** he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

Acts 1:6 When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, ***wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?***

Matt. 11:12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and ***the violent take it by force.***

John 19:14 And it was the preparation of the passover, and about the sixth hour: and he saith unto the Jews, Behold your King! 15 But they cried out, Away with him, away with him, crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? ***The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.***

Note: Since Jesus could not give to them the throne of David, they sought by other ways to obtain it. As the Jews of Old Testament multiple times rejected Christ in Principle for a temporal kingdom: refusing to leave Egypt or return to it, refusing to return from Babylon, etc., so those in the New Testament rejected Him in Person. Just so have christians rejected Christ to obtain another temporal kingdom.

Matt. 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.

2Tim. 4:10 For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia.

Note: If you go to a church that preaches error, you're not keeping the Sabbath. But some will say "Oh there is a difference between seeing an Idol and hearing one, really! If you hear you cannot keep the 10 Commandments, this is an error by this you are not keeping the Sabbath. If you hear the church is the Bride then that church cannot be the Bride for this is an error. If you hear you cannot be

Righteous, this is an error for Jesus Taught in the sermon on the mount that to keep the 10 Commandments, this is an error for Christ taught it “is a reproduction in themselves of the character of Christ.” MB 55.1; Due. 6:25. If you hear that faith is greater than Works/charity this is an error, for Paul tell us so in 1Cor. 13:13; Matt. 25:37.
