

Eric Metaxas who spoke at Rededicate 250 a religious event paid by taxes, argues that the Founding Fathers intended to model the United States after the biblical Sinai Covenant.

If the Founding Fathers of the United States did intend to model America after the Sinai Covenant **they'd been wholly-completely disqualified to found a nation for their total ignorance of the New Testament and the New Covenant:—**

Hebrews 8:6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. 7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. 8 For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: 9 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord. 10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people: 11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest. 12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more. 13 In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away. Ps 78:10,56.

Hebrews 10:15 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before, 16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; 17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. 19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; 21 And having an high priest over the house of God; 22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised; . . . 28 He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: 29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified," to go back to the old covenant an "unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

Hebrews 12:23 To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, 24 And to **Jesus the mediator of the new covenant**, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

Why would Pastors teach the founders of the United States wanted the Sinai Covenant? They have rejected Christ's words (this is antiChrist) and are unfit to teach the Word of God. Pastors want Slavery and power to punish those with death who reject their interpretation of the Scriptures for New Testament evidences. Satan will personate Christ and will say the things he has prompted men to believe as truth.

Hebrews 9:1 Then verily the first covenant had also **ordinances of divine service**, and a worldly sanctuary. 2 For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the sanctuary. 3 And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all; 4 Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;

Eph. 2:15 **Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances;** for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; 16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

Acts. 15:10 Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put **a yoke upon the neck** of the disciples, ***which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?***

John 1:45 Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, **of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write**, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

5:39 Search the scriptures; for ***in them*** ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which ***testify of me***.

5:40 **And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life.**

Note: They thought they had life in the ceremonial law, and *they* were the door of salvation; yet that gift of life was only in Christ! which those things prefigured. Therefore had they accepted him, He would not have sacrifices! *1 Sam. 15:22*. Paul, like Christ's teachings did away with the external, ceremonial law, placing the true meaning on those lessons which it taught worshipping the Father in spirit and not in the letter:—

(Matt. 12:6 But I say unto you, That in this place is *one greater* than the temple.

12:7 But if *ye had known* what this meaneth, *I will have mercy, and not sacrifice*, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.

12:8 For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.

John 4:21 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, *the hour cometh*, when ye shall *neither* in this mountain, nor yet *at Jerusalem* (three times a year), worship the Father. 4:23 But *the hour cometh, and now is*, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father *in spirit* (not external forms) *and in truth*: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. *John 12:23; 13:1; 14:17*. John 6:63 It is the *spirit* that quickeneth; the *flesh* profiteth nothing:

5:46 For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for *he wrote of me*.

5:47 But *if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?*

Luke 18:31 Then he took unto him the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and *all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished*.

22:37 For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be *accomplished in me*, And he was reckoned among the transgressors: *for the things concerning me have an end*.

Rom. 10:4 For *Christ is the end of the law*—for righteousness—to every one that believeth.

1Cor. 5:7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. *For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:*

Acts 24:25 Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe *all that the prophets* have spoken:

24:26 Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?

24:27 And beginning at *Moses and all the prophets*, he expounded unto them in all

the scriptures the things concerning himself.

Luke 24:44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the *law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms*, concerning me. 24:48 And ye are witnesses of these things.

Acts 3:18 But those things, which God before had showed by the mouth of all his *prophets*, that Christ should suffer, he hath so fulfilled.
