Note: The words that appear in bold italics of the NIV are not in strong's concordance and are not in the original texts. In the NIV verses 3,12 and 14 contradict 15. Because in the NIV the two horn beast acts on first beasts behalf, then forces the worship of itself. Both cannot be true. Not so in the KJV! These changes are designed by Protestants to remove themselves from this and other Prophecies.
