



1850 Adventist Prophetic Chart

Considered to be the first Seventh-day Adventist Prophetic Chart. Otis Nichols, an Adventist lithographer from Dorchester, Massachusetts, printed 300 copies. The original is 44 inches tall by 31 inches wide. The hand colored version—which is represented here—was offered for two dollars in January 1851. The chart was designed according to James White, “to supply those who travel and teach the present truth.”
